<b>Proposed Question</b>	What is the primary issue the Aadhaar system seeks to address?
<b>Proposed Answer</b>	Providing identity documentation to India's 1.2 billion residents.

<b>Proposed Question</b>	What are three challenges the government of India faces when trying to document residents?
<b>Proposed Answer</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• when people move across state lines most identification documentation becomes invalid</li> <li>• existing physical identity tokens can only be authenticated manually because the token can only be verified when the photo of the individual is printed on the token</li> <li>• the government has no authenticated audit system in place resulting in a high rate of fake documents and unauthorized copies</li> </ul>

<b>Proposed Question</b>	What does UIDAI stand for?
<b>Proposed Answer</b>	Unique Identity Authority of India

<b>Proposed Question</b>	What are the objectives of the Aadhaar system?
<b>Proposed Answer</b>	To provide a common platform that can be used across all applications and serve to clean-up existing databases through the uniqueness of the ID, improve targeting and delivery of services to the intended beneficiary, and reduce the cost of delivering these services. Additionally, the Aadhaar system seeks to make the process more cost effective, accountable, and transparent for India's underprivileged citizens.
